Call 9-1-1 to report hate crimes to the Police

Racial and religious hate crimes and threats are illegal.

Report a Hate Crime if you experience:

- ◆ Threats
- ◆ Theft
- ◆ Assault
- ◆ Vandalism
- ◆ Arson
- ◆ Rape
- ◆ Murder

... because of your **race, color, religion, ancestry, or national origin.**

What to do if it happens to you:

- 1) Protect yourself. Do not respond to taunts
- 2) Call 911 immediately. Say that you are reporting a Hate Crime
- 3) Describe the people who committed the crime
- 4) Make notes about the time, place, and details
- 5) File a police report
- 6) Be a witness if someone else is a victim

**The Police Department will investigate
all reports of racial and religious hate crimes.**
