City of Seattle's Request for Information regarding a Public-Private Partnership for the Purpose of Providing State-of-the-Art Wireless Mission-Critical Voice and Broadband Data Capabilities for Public Safety and General Government dated December 9, 2011 is hereby amended as follows:

1. The due date for RFI responses is extended from February 10, 2012 to February 29, 2012. Responses are due at 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time.
2. The vendor conference for this RFI will be held on January 26, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. Pacific Time in the [International Auditorium](#) (click link to see directions) at the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, 17801 International Blvd (Pacific Highway S), Seattle, WA 98158. Teleconference call-in lines will be available (call-in numbers to be announced) and minutes/notes of the conference will be taken and publicly available.
3. Paragraph i. on Pages 3-4 of the RFI is hereby amended as follows:
 - i. The problems stated above are not unique to City of Seattle or the Region. They are faced by local governments nationwide. The solution(s) provided in this RFI may very well apply to other regions throughout the country. Therefore, this RFI effort is endorsed by the Chief Technology Officer in the Office of Science and Technology Policy in the White House.
