In the approaching months ahead, Fire Station 9, located at 3829 Linden Avenue North, will be rebuilt. To ensure continued fire and emergency response to the neighborhoods served by Fire Station 9, fire crews will move to a temporary facility during the station rebuild which will be located on City owned property at 3500 Interlake Ave North. It is expected that the Temporary Fire Station will be active in your neighborhood for about 15 months beginning in the spring of 2012. Site preparation work has begun and the temporary structures will be placed on the site in November. They will not be occupied until next spring.

As a result of the Temporary Fire Station, there will be some temporary impacts to parking in the neighborhood to allow the fire engine to exit the site. "No Parking" designations will appear in areas needed to allow the fire crew to respond safely.
