The Seattle School District has applied to the City of Seattle to modify zoning standards for Rainier Beach High School to install a 7-ft X 7.5-ft double faced, electronic, changing-image sign on an existing monopole that supports a back lit style reader board. The design height of the new sign will remain at the same height of the existing sign and the School District is seeking a continuance of this height allowance. The sign will be facing east and west on South Henderson Street. The existing reader board will be removed. The new sign will enhance the ability of the school to advertise school events to their surrounding community.
