### Project Scope

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is replacing its open reservoirs with underground structures that will improve the quality and security of our water supply and provide new public open space on the reservoir lids. Lid construction is underway at Maple Leaf Reservoir and once complete, park construction will begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2012.

The Parks and Green Spaces Levy allocated \$5,000,000 for the new park development on the Maple Leaf Reservoir. The scope of this project includes the development of a master plan for the new park space and the existing Maple Leaf Playground, and implementation of the plan. This project is part of the 2008 Parks and Greens Spaces Levy.
